


BULLETIN 3

01.10.2022 - Temp O Italian Cup, ECTO (European Cup Trail Orienteering), WRE Roncegno Terme

COMPETITION CENTER: Roncegno Golf Club, 46.046704, 11.420701, open from 14:00. Parking is available close to the Competition Center. Accessible toilettes will be available in the Competition Center. There is a bar inside the CC.

EMBARGOED AREA:



MAP: Roncegno Terme Centro Sportivo, ISSprOM, 1:4000, contour interval 2m, mapped in 2022.

FORMULA: Temp O. 6 stations, each one with 5 tasks and 6 flags. Z (Zero) answer is possible, when no flag is in the right position. Time limit in each station: 150s.

CLASSES: Elite, Direct, Beginners (same course).

ZERO TOLERANCE: The zero tolerance is 4m, no other conditions. This means that in case of a Zero flag, the flags are apart more than 4m from the correct position.

MODEL: A model station is available at the parking close to the CC.

FIRST START: at 15:00. Distance of the start from the CC: 300m / 10m. It is mandatory to wear the bib number. Start order following the start list published.

COURSE INFORMATION: Length 600m / 0m. Follow the strips and the directions provided by the marshals. The path is accessible but there is some steep descents. Assistants will be provided in the critical points.

PROCEDURE: In every station the competitor receives a bunch of 5 loose maps. The competitor can request the bound maps if he/she wishes. Likewise, he/she can request to give the answers pointing at the letters. The official will declaim the formula "6 flags, ALPHA – BRAVO – CHARLIE - DELTA - ECHO - FOXTROT– Time starts now!". Only at this moment the competitor can open the bunch and solve the first question and the followings. It is not allowed to go to the next map before answering the previous, or go back to the previous map. Time limit for every station is **150 seconds**. 20sec before the term the official will warn the competitor saying "20 seconds!".

ANSWERS: The answers must be given clearly using the english phonetic alphabet (Alpha, Bravo, Charlie, Delta, Echo, Foxtrot, Zero). The answers and the overall time are recorded with ANT system. After completing a station, the competitor goes on along the path till the STOP sign, and wait the call to the next station.

FINISH: Distance of the CC from the last station: 100m.

PRIZEGIVING: at the end of the Temp O Competition. Prizes for the best three in each class.

02.10.2022 - Pre O Italian Championship, ECTO (European Cup Trail Orienteering), WRE Malga Valfontane

COMPETITION CENTER: Competition Center will be located at Malga Valfontane , (46.104752; 11.665307). Parking for wheelchairs and other P-class competitors will be at the CC. Parking for other competitors will be on the road north-west to the CC, before reaching it. Parking to CC: 0-300m. Please respect the forbidden area signs and do not enter the competition area. (i.e. do NOT drive past the competition center/secretary). It is not allowed to go to the east and south part of the CC terrace, there will be stripes signaling the forbidden areas (RED area). As Malga Valfontane is closed, a food truck will be present for refreshments.

MODEL: 5 warm-up PreO controls with solutions will be available directly at the CC. (BLUE area - it is not possible to go to the terrain of the warm-up controls, just solve them from the CEC)



MAP: Malga Valfontane, ISSprOM 1:4000; contour interval 2,5m, mapped in 2022.

CLASSES: Open Elite, Paralympics and Direct/Beginners (Esordienti)

ZERO TOLERANCE: Zero tolerance follows the IOF “Guidelines on zero problems”, v. 1.0, no other conditions. If the answer of a task is Zero, there are no flag closer to the correct spot than 4m. A 100% increase every 100m distance is calculated for long distance controls (e.g. a control 180m from the viewpoint will have zero tolerance of 8m, a control more than 200m will have 12 m zero tolerance).

FIRST START: 9.30 a.m. Starting interval 2 min.

Direct and Beginners will have free start between 9.45 and 11.15 a.m..

The 2 (x 3 tasks) timed controls, only for Open elite and Paralympics, will be directly at the start, before the PreO course.

COURSE INFORMATION:

Controls can be punched in any order. Please pay attention to the different decision points, they will be marked in the terrain along the route. Red/white stripes will be used from the decision point to show the angle of the flags to consider for that control(s).

FINISH: After the finish, competitors will go back to the secretary for punch download. Please respect other competitors still in the race and do not communicate with each other. We expect a strong fair play from all participants, some officials will anyway be present along the course.

TIME MEASUREMENT: The competition time will be recorded using Toepunch.

PUNCHING: for Open Elite / Paralympic classes the Toe Punch system will be used (for info see the official

website <http://toe.yq.cz/>). In addition of the Toe chips, a control card will be provided to each competitor as a backup in case of a failure of a Toe station. Punchers will be provided at the start, but personal punchers are allowed. If an answer on the control card differs from the one in the Toe chip, the latter shall prevail.

For the Direct/ Beginner classes the manual punching with control card will be used. Punchers will be provided at the start, but personal punchers are allowed.

TIMED STATION: There are 2 timed stations, with 6 flags and 3 tasks each. No zero answer in the timed controls.

When the competitor is given a set of maps, the competitor must verify that the order of the maps is correct by seeing all the numbers on the right-hand side. If you see a crossed check box instead of a number, immediately inform the marshal about this, and wait while the problem is resolved. The competitor is introduced to the terrain with a standard routine. The officials step aside and one of them points out all flags (Alfa, Bravo, Charlie, Delta, Echo, Foxtrot). Immediately following the pointing out of the last flag the official invites the competitor to view the map(s) with the words "the time starts now", at which point the competitor may look at the first map.

When answering, please speak loud and clear using the letters Alfa, Bravo, Charlie, Delta, Echo, Foxtrot. If you rather point the answers, inform the marshal at each station.

Loose and bound maps will be prepared (with TOM) at the timed controls.

The time limit for each station is **90 seconds**. 20" before the deadline the officials will warn the competitor by saying: "20 seconds".

PRIZEGIVING: at the end of the Pre O Competiton. Prizes for the best three in each class.
